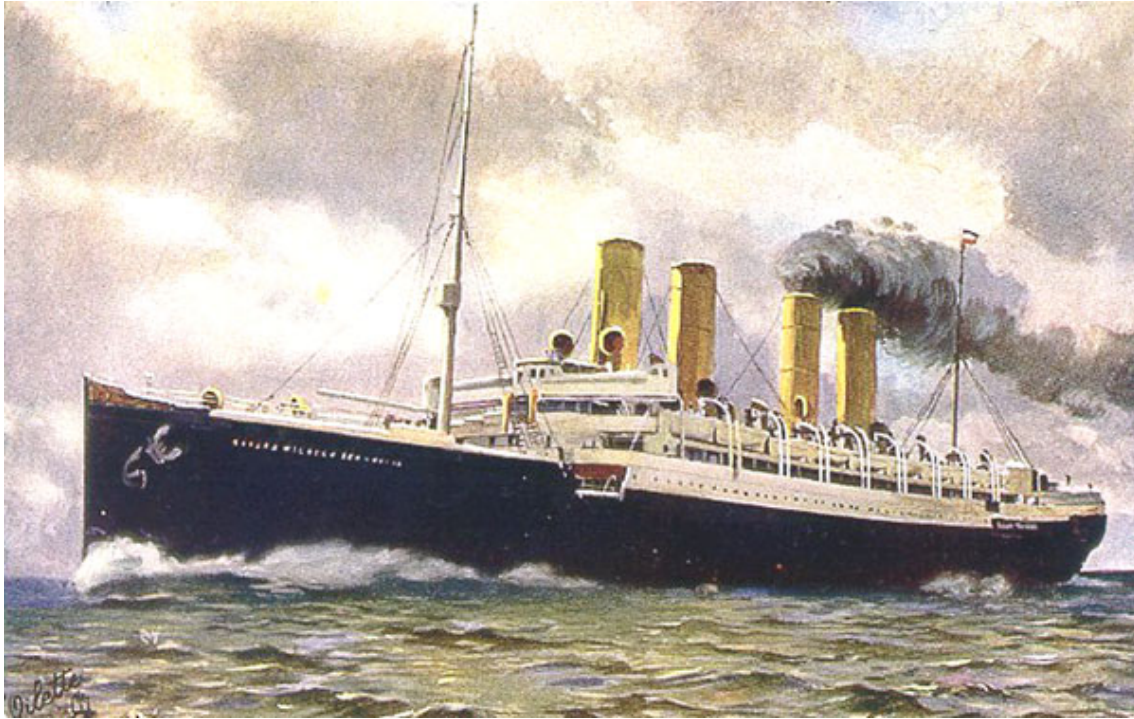
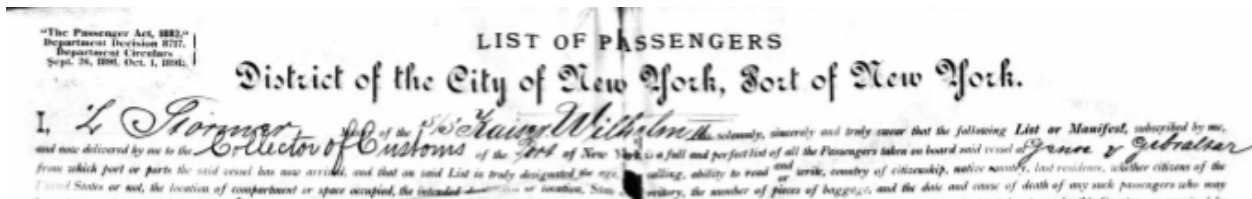


# Passengers on the Kaiser Wilhelm II
